## Inpatient Rehabilitation in Auckland

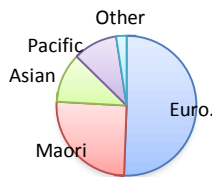


### Over-18 clients

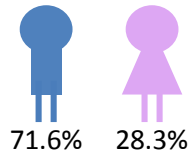

#### Gender



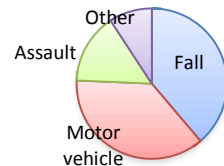
**92%** of 18+ clients had a traumatic brain injury.

Clients stayed for an average of 40.1 days (range: 0-180 days).

Functionally, clients improved by 31.5 FIM points, from moderate disability at admission to mild disability at discharge.

89% of clients were discharged to home.

TBIs were most often due to car accidents and falls.



**8%** of 18+ clients had a stroke or non-traumatic brain injury.

Clients stayed for an average of 80.9 days (range: 7-335 days).

Functionally, clients improved by 6.7 FIM points. On average, clients had moderate disability.

71% of clients were discharged to home.

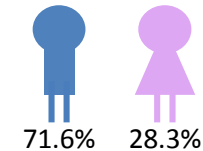

### Under-18 clients

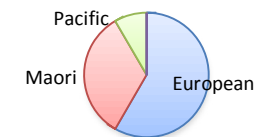

Functionally, clients improved by 25.2 FIM points, from moderate disability at admission to mild disability at discharge.

100% of clients were discharged to home.

TBIs were most often due to car accidents.
