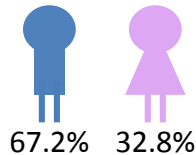

Age

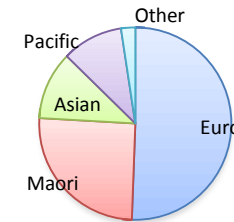
99% of clients were 18 or older.
Average: 46.3 years (Range: 18 - 78)

One client was 17; he had a TBI. He stayed for 67 days and returned home.

78% of 18+ clients had a traumatic brain injury.

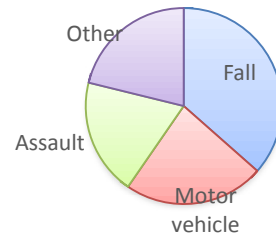
22% of 18+ clients had a stroke or non-traumatic brain injury.

Clients stayed for an average of 47.7 days (range: 2-178 days).

Functionally, clients improved by 34.5 FIM points, from moderate disability at admission to mild disability at discharge.

96% of clients were discharged to home.

TBIs were most often due to car accidents and falls.



Clients stayed for an average of 63.3 days (range: 10-183 days).

Functionally, clients improved by 16.1 FIM points. On average, clients had moderate disability.

87% of clients were discharged to home.
