- 31 clients had a full year of rehab in our service during 2016.

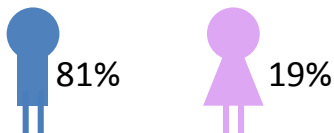

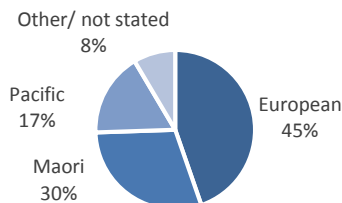


The general goals of long-term residential rehabilitation are to:

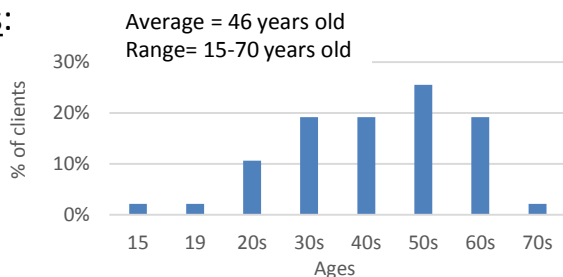
- Maintain function
