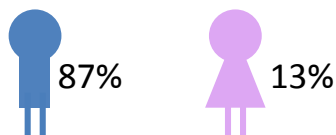

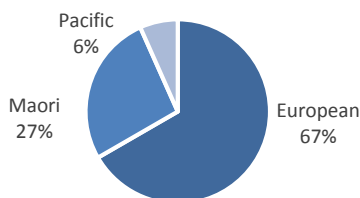


The general goals of long-term residential rehabilitation are to:

- Give satisfaction

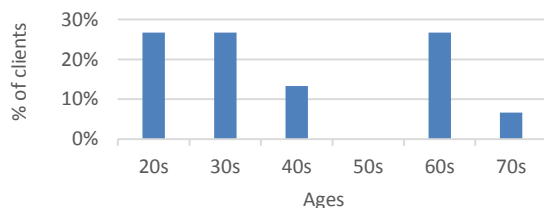
