Our scorecards give information about our client groups and their rehabilitation outcomes. Intensive rehabilitation has a goal of three hours of therapy per day.

**92.6%** of clients, and **92.3%** of family-whānau...

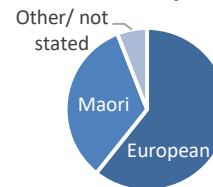

### Over-18 clients

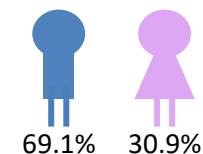

#### Gender



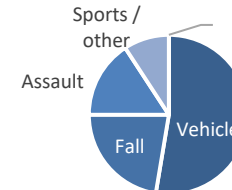
**90.5%** of 18+ clients had a traumatic brain injury (TBI).

TBI clients stayed for an average of 56.6 days (range: 2 - 360 days).

Functionally, TBI clients improved by 35.4 FIM points: from moderate disability at admission to mild disability at discharge.

94.7% of TBI clients were discharged to home.

TBIs were most often due to car accidents and falls.



**9.5%** of 18+ clients had a stroke or non-traumatic brain injury.

This group of clients stayed for an average of 100.3 days (range: 40 - 188 days).

Functionally, clients improved by 14.6 FIM points: from severe disability at admission to moderate disability at discharge.

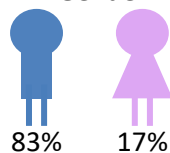
75% of clients were discharged to home.

### Under-18 clients

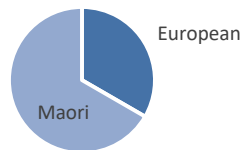

**83.3%** of under-18 clients had a traumatic brain injury. One client had non-traumatic brain injuries.

Under-18 clients stayed for an average of 25.5 days (range: 10-57 days).

Functionally, clients improved by 33.8 FIM points, from moderate disability at admission to mild disability at discharge.

100% of clients were discharged to home.

TBIs were most often due to car accidents.
