- Range: a few weeks to more than 5 years

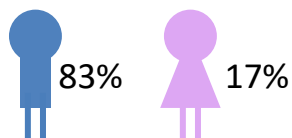

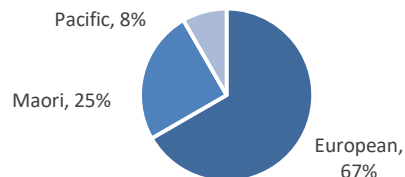

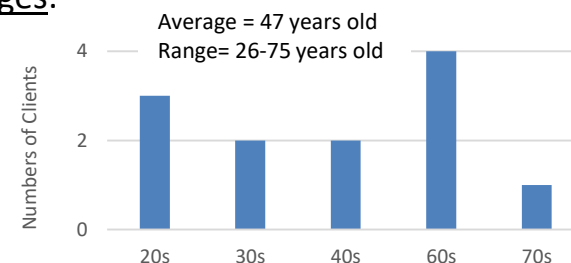
