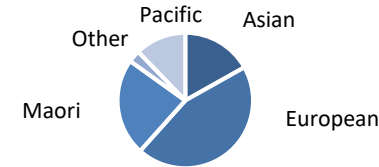

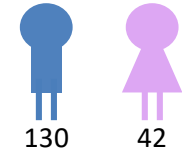

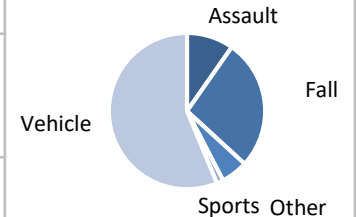
84% of 18+ clients had a traumatic brain injury (TBI).

TBI clients stayed for an average of 46 days (range: 4 - 221 days).

Functionally, TBI clients improved by 27 FIM points.

81% of TBI clients were discharged to home.

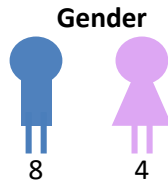
TBIs were most often due to car accidents and falls.



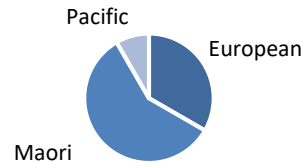
Under-18 clients

Ethnicity



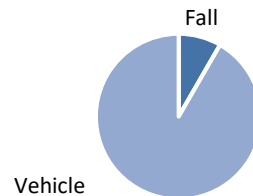
100% of under-18 clients had a traumatic brain injury.

Under-18 clients stayed for an average of 26 days (range: 8-92 days).

Functionally, under-18 clients improved by 32 FIM points.

100% of clients were discharged to home.

TBIs were most often due to car accidents.



16% of 18+ clients had a stroke or non-traumatic brain injury.

This group of clients stayed for an average of 63 days (range: 12 – 262 days).

Functionally, clients improved by 26 FIM points.

79% of clients were discharged to home.
