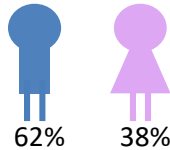

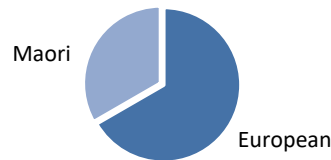

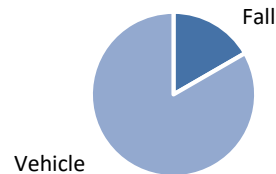
92% of under-18 clients had a traumatic brain injury.

Under-18 clients stayed for an average of 40 days (range: 1 -104 days).

Functionally, under-18 clients improved by an average of 32 FIM points.

100% of clients were discharged to home.

TBIs were most often due to car accidents.

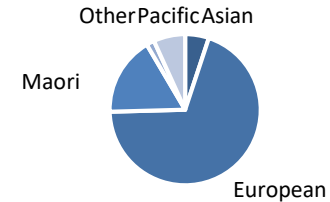


Over-18 clients

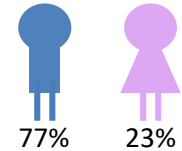

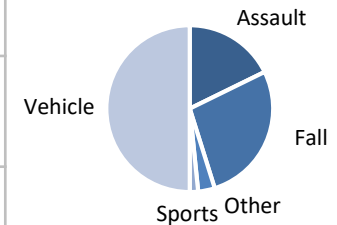
88% of 18+ clients had a traumatic brain injury (TBI).

TBI clients stayed for an average of 49 days (range: 1 - 216 days).

Functionally, TBI clients improved by an average of 30 FIM points.

83% of TBI clients were discharged to home.

TBIs were most often due to car accidents and falls.



12% of 18+ clients had a stroke or non-traumatic brain injury.

This group of clients stayed for an average of 71 days (range: 21 - 99 days).

Functional improvement data, for those this was capture on, was an average improvement of 24 FIM points.

55% of clients were discharged to home.
