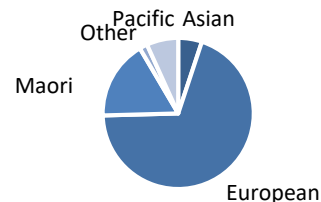

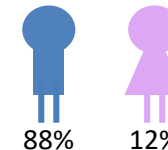

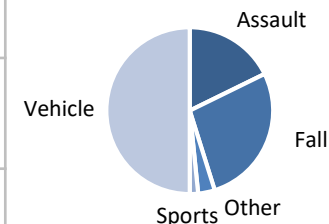


89% of 18+ clients had a traumatic brain injury (TBI).

TBI clients stayed for an average of 56 days (range: 1 - 216 days).

TBIs were most often due to car accidents and falls.

Functionally, TBI clients improved by an average of 32 FIM points.



80% of TBI clients were discharged to home.

11% of 18+ clients had a stroke or non-traumatic brain injury.

This group of clients stayed for an average of 56 days (range: 21 - 99 days)

Functionally, clients improved by 26 FIM points on average (of those recorded)

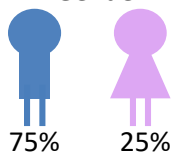

Under-18 clients

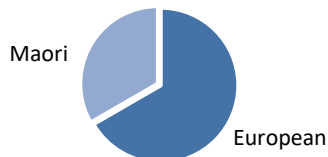

Ethnicity

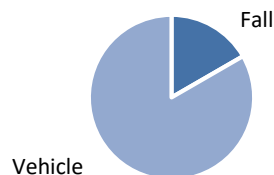


100% of under-18 clients had a traumatic brain injury.

Under-18 clients stayed for an average of 70 days (range: 35-104 days).

TBIs were most often due to car accidents.
