WHY DID THEY SEE US?



Average hours of rehabilitation input is individualised to meet the needs of the individuals. The average is aimed at 3 hours a day. This is made of direct allied health and Nursing rehabilitation contacts and the rehabilitation directed activities (self-directed and support staff assisted)

TBIs were most often due to **car accidents & falls**

WHAT WERE THE OUTCOMES?



90% of clients and **78%** of Family-whānau

“Satisfied” or “Very Satisfied”

On occasion there is a need for further investigation that can only be done within a hospital environment. Last year there were 29 people requiring hospital level reviews with a total of 41 returns being required.

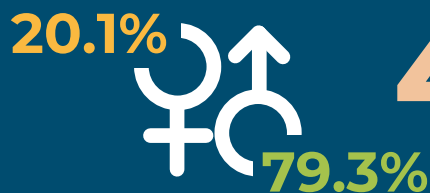

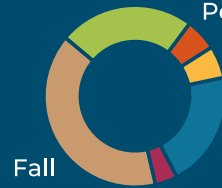
